Anti Ragging Cell is one of the important parts of Our Educational institution Mechanism. As per the guidelines of UGC under the Act of 1956, which is modified as UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009, Establishment of Anti-Ragging Cell is very compulsory.

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee

Anti Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory Committee in preparing a culture of Ragging free Environment in the college Campus. The main objectives of the cell are as follows---

- To aware the students of dehumanizing effect of ragging inherent in its perversity.
- To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
- To promptly & strongly deal with the incident of ragging brought to our notice.
- To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students.

- Any act of Indiscipline, teasing or handling with rudeness.
- Any act that prevents disrupts the regular Academic Activity.

- Any activity which is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, psychological harm or creates fear of Apprehension.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful Expenditure.
- Any Act of Physical abuse causing Assaults, harm or danger to health.
- Any act of abuse by spoken words, e-mails, SMS, or public insult etc.
- Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
- Any act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of Criminal forces, Trespass or intimidation.
- Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

Punishment for those who found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the Campus or even outside the Campus shall be liable to be one or more of the following punishments-

- Debarring from appearing in any Sessional Test/ University Examination.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
- Suspension from the college.
- With holding of the result.
